

## Personal Data

The Nairn Allotment Society (NAS) will use your personal data only in order that the NAS can fulfil its legitimate interests, its society and statutory functions.

The data held will include your name, address and contact details including phone and email so we can keep in touch with you about NAS matters and for the purposes of raising due revenues.

At all times we will comply with the Data Protection Acts 2018 which replaced the Data Protection Act 1998, and the EU GDPR, which came into force in May 2018. In becoming a member of the Nairn Allotment Society and signing your annual Plot Holder Agreement you give consent for us to hold this data. If you are on the waiting list for an allotment we hold some basic data for you. You have the same rights as full members as to how we use your data.

You are entitled to ask for the information we hold about you, you may ask for your information to be removed from our database and may request it to be updated.
