Code of Practice for Visiting Groups

Nairn Allotment Society wishes all visitors have an enjoyable visit to our allotments.

Your wellbeing and safety is of paramount importance and we ask that you follow these simple rules:-

All leaders/teachers must ensure they supervise the children/people in their care at all times.

We wish to remind leaders/teachers that the primary responsibility for the welfare of the children/people/vulnerable adults in their care rests with them at all times.

We expect all visitors to display courtesy and respect for others on site.

Due to widespread use of compost/manure/organic matter /chemicals etc, group leaders should advise visitors in their care not to touch any materials except that laid on for their express use. We recommend the use of gardening gloves to minimise risk.

Group leaders should advise children/people in their care that plants, flowers, nuts or berries with NAS sites should not be picked and/or eaten without express permission from the committee.

Group leaders are reminded to stick to their planned programme of events. Do not permit children/adults in your care to wander onto individual plots.

Group leaders should ensure safe use of tools.

Whilst care is taken to limit traffic on our sites, be aware that vehicles may require access.

Extreme care should be exercised crossing car parks.

Leaders must ensure children/people in their care maintain a safe distance from the pond by sticking to the paths.

Leaders must ensure children/people in their care maintain a safe distance from the barrel planters and the slope by the meeting room.

Toilets are located at both sites including a composting toilet at Sandown.

Hand washing – our only facility is cold running water. Please ensure anti-bacterial hand wipes/gels are brought with you and used before eating snacks.

Please remove any litter generated from the site.

Basic First Aid kits are located in the meeting room at Mill Road and the compost toilet at Sandown.
